

Gianne received her BFA from UC Irvine in the 1970s during the defining years of the Minimalist movement under masters such as Judy Chicago and Tony DeLap. Glanne has embraced the concept of sustainability and is committed to help frame the discussion of conservation through the aesthetics of painting water wise gardens. She has completed 14 residencies in the past nine years.
