Item (4)A. Minutes of the April 7, 2015 meeting.

The following corrections are suggested:

Page 2, last paragraph: "**Christy Kristi** Jackson provided additional information about the independent arborist ..." [note: full name is "Kristin," suggested spelling is from March minutes]

Page 3, motion: "... additionally, provide information to the neighbors regarding a 48" box Tomlinson **Ash** Tree as a replacement tree, ..."

Page 4, paragraph 2: "Assistant Chief (**Lifeguard Operations**) Rob Williams introduced himself ..."

Page 6, first full paragraph, last sentence: "He urged the Commission to keep the current regulation in place and **keeping keep** the area for body boarders."

Page 7, paragraph 5: "Amy **Tilo**, Endless Sun Surf School, stated ..." [? I haven't attempted to verify most of the speakers' names, but in this case the names given on the school's [website](#) and [Facebook page](#) are Tim and Amy **Reda** (formerly [Amy Lowry](#) ?)]

Page 8, line 1: "**Brett Brent** Ranek stated that he is a retired City of Newport Beach Lifeguard ..."

Page 8, paragraph 2: "Tim **Tilo**, Endless Sun Surf School stated ..." [See earlier comment. Should "Tilo" be "Reda"? As a City contractor, perhaps someone could ask who the speakers were?]

Page 8, after close of public discussion, paragraph 1, sentence 3: "He reminded the audience that everyone will get "another bite **of** the apple" when this matter is presented to City Council." [Isn't the expression in this context "another bite **at** the apple"?)

Page 8, after close of public discussion, paragraph 3, last sentence: "He urged the Commission to consider Mr. **Reddick's Ranek's** statements and reiterated the need for a procedure for enforcement."

Page 8, line 3 from end: "... it is the decision by the Lifeguard Captain and **/** or Watch Commander."

Page 10, Item D, paragraph 1: "Assistant Chief (**Lifeguard Operations**) Rob Williams ..."

Page 13, paragraph 2 from end: "Kevin Murphy stated that the fact **of** lifeguards not being around during specific times of the year should not result as a detriment to wave riders."

Page 14, after close of public discussion, paragraph 2: "Josh **Joaquim Yocam** again stated that he was speaking on behalf of ... and stated that the Association stands against **recommendation recommendations** 1 and 2."
